Dec. 30, 1919

Motion by McDonnell & second by Haley that the Trustees attend the meeting of the new council and ask for a donation to the fire co., also report the bad condition of the roof and to ask them to place screens on the windows on the lower floor.

Motion by Haley & Cain that we appoint a committee to look after the prices & terms on Victorolas. Carried

Committee John Lavelle & Wm Kane.

Motion by Haley & Lavelle that the members shooting pool will pay one cent a cue. The trustees & secretary to draw up rules governing the shooting game etc.
